

How hourly matching works on Kiemenai point transferring gas between Latvia and Lithuania no matter of direction.

To facilitate the transportation of the required volume of gas, it is essential to adhere to the following procedures:

- Hourly nomination values are checked and compared with the booked hourly entry / exit capacity.
- During the matching process, each hour is matched, and the lesser rule applies – meaning, that if (re)nominated hourly values submitted to each TSO differ, the lowest hourly value will be matched. For example, if the nomination on TSO1 is 100 and on TSO2 is 90, the matched value will be 90.
- To achieve desirable nomination values must be submitted for (re)nomination on both TSO Platforms for each hour throughout the gas day.
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- The matching process between the (re)nominations submitted by the Operators takes place every hour.
- If a nomination is submitted only to one TSO, it will be matched to the latest confirmed value. Meaning, that reduction of value is possible if nomination is sent only to one TSO, however, increase of renomination is not possible due to lesser rule.
- Only future hours starting from 2nd hour in the future can be changed. For example, if renomination is submitted 12:15 during the gas day, only hourly values starting from hour starting 15:00 will be taken into account for matching.
